Must be read at the first meeting following receipt, before being filed for reference.

1. **Sec. 211 (pg. 30-31)** – Standing rules (Auxiliaries, County Councils, Districts and Departments) Auxiliaries, County Councils, Districts and Departments may establish Standing rules to provide for specified operations, activities, events, expenses and disbursements between meetings provided such rules do not conflict with the National or Department Bylaws. Custom has the status of a standing rule, and standing rules may be amended, modified, or rescinded at any meeting. If prior notice is given, the vote is by majority vote of those members present. If previous notice is not given, the vote is by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those members present. Standing rules become effective immediately.
PLEASE NOTE: You do not have to send these to National or the Department. However if you have any questions, we will be glad to help in any way.
2. **Sec. 106 – Transfers** (pg. 17)
Applicants who wish to transfer between Auxiliaries need not show proof of eligibility but instead must provide their current membership card as this proves eligibility has been established and approved with their current auxiliary or as a Member At Large.
3. **Sec. 813A – Auxiliary Treasurer** (pg. 81)
The Auxiliary Treasurer shall hold all funds and securities belonging to the Auxiliary in a FDIC or equivalent Banking Institution in the name of the Auxiliary. **Please Note: The Treasurer keeps the check book and handles all the money – not the President.**
4. **Sec. 902 – Meeting Etiquette** (pg. 93)
Smoking: To include but not limited to tobacco products, e-cigarettes, etc., is not allowed during an Auxiliary meeting.
Alcoholic Beverages: No alcoholic beverages will be permitted during Auxiliary meetings.
5. Please remember to be kind and loving when you speak to others. Do not call people out in meetings for things that *might* have happened. Talk to them in private before or after a meeting. No one likes to be belittled in front of others. No one likes to hear foul language as well.

Today (11/21) our membership is 88.56% and we need 659 to be 100%. We are behind 2% at this time last year. For the past several years we have been 100% at our Spring Conference so let's continue this wonderful tradition. At this time we have 12 Auxiliaries that are 100% or more. Many of you are on the line and can be 100% with just a few more members. Let's get those dues in!!! **DO NOT HOLD THEM.** It is the end of the dues year so I am sure people will be sending them in. Dues notices will go out again the 1st week of December to those members in Auxiliaries not 100%. If those Auxiliaries who are 100% still have some members that haven't paid, it will be YOUR responsibility to mail those notices.

Remember all officers need to be paid by the end of December so they are not removed by National the first of the year. Dept. Secretary Janey has sent an email as a reminder. We still have 4 that are not paid as of this mailing.

Enclosed in this mailing is a community service report form that can be used by Auxiliaries to fill out for their VFW Posts. Help your Post by reporting in the programs listed as we all know we help them a lot in the programs.

If anyone needs help in their Auxiliary with ANYTHING, please do not hesitate to let one of the line officers know. We want our Auxiliaries to be strong and working for our Veterans in every capacity. Remember to share what you are doing on our Facebook page! There have been many good things across this state being shared already! Keep those tugboats moving!

The Line Officers and I extend to each of you a Merry Christmas. Enjoy it with family. Stay safe. Let's hope that 2023 will be the very best for us all!!! Please remember me in your prayers as I will have my hip surgery after Thanksgiving.
